■ **21st January 2015 - Christine Blower, General Secretary of the National Union of Teachers**

With nearly fifteen registered teachers' unions in the UK, the National Union of Teachers is the largest with just over 300k members. Christine Blower is the eleventh General Secretary of the National Union of Teachers.
